The portable, computerized Dinemapp, which measures a patient's vital signs, offers a non-invasive method of closely monitoring patients. It automatically takes vital signs so a nurse can either attend to other needs the patient may have or attend to other patients.

The Dinemapp machine will be used for patients returning from the OR who require regular monitoring of blood pressure, pulse and blood oxygen levels and will be used daily on approximately 15 patients each week.
